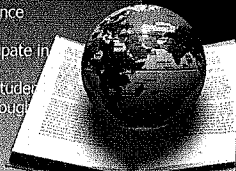

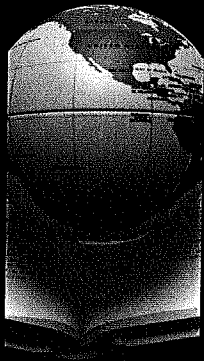
- ... 623,805 Foreign college students in the U.S.

- ... 28% Of foreign students in Oklahoma come from China, India or Japan
- ... 12.5% Of foreign students in Oklahoma come from Mexico or one of 31 Latin American countries
- ... 34% Increase in the number of Oklahoma students participating in study abroad since 2006-07
- ... <1% Of all Oklahoma students participate in study abroad
- ... \$178M Contribution by international students annually to the state's plus economy through tuition, fees and living expenses
